It is my pleasure to nominate Steve Tedesco; proven as a distinguished alum and superior athlete during his four years at Bishop Fallon.

Having personally run with Steve our sophomore thru senior years, I know of his accomplishments first hand. As the year book points out he was an accomplished track and cross country runner and was on our dominating Cross Country team that defeated Timon high school after 13 years. Not only was his exceptional athletic performance displayed during 4 years of outdoor track and cross country but also during three years of indoor track. Starting with his freshman year, he set the Delaware Park Freshman single lap record in 7min 12sec. As a sophomore he placed 1st and won the Varsity All Catholic in 14 min 32 seconds; only the 2nd runner under 15 min after Tom Ryan from Timon the previous year. Steve went on to win the 440 yard dash in the All Catholic in our senior year at UB Rotary Field. He dove over the finish line to pile up in the cinders but he won. It was this grittiness and determination that he brought to all of his classmates the form of leadership that left a significant impression on all those around him.

Steve later distinguished himself in developing first in the meat trades and then in developing with his brothers Chuck and Paul three Super Duper supermarkets in WNY. Through his company he supported many local charities and programs and enjoyed significant success for a number of years. I recommend Steve Tedesco to be inducted into the Bishop Fallon Hall of Fame.
