I would like to nominate Dennis Thiele, ('69) graduate of Bishop Fallon to the Hall of Fame. He would qualify for inclusion for the categories of Distinguished Athlete and Distinguished Alumni.

While at Fallon, he competed in and won the Courier Express newspaper's Turkey Day Cross Country 5 mile race in 1968 while running for the newly formed Fallon Flyers Fathers Club. In 1969, he finished 8th in the All Catholic Cross Country Championship Race. Dennis also holds school record times in the mile and two mile track events.

After graduation, Dennis continued his education at Buffalo State, where he was one of the first freshmen to make the Varsity Cross Country team. He received his Bachelor of Science degree in Industrial Arts in 1973.

Dennis married and moved to Maryland where he is now ending a 36 year distinguished teaching and coaching career. He has received several teaching awards, including the McDonalds "Ray Croc" teacher achievement award and the Outstanding Educator Award from Philadelphia University. He has also been recognized by the National Youth leadership Forum for his contributions to education as well an entry in "Who's Who" of American Educators. He has earned a Master's Degree in Education and a diploma in Wildlife Forestry Conservation.

Dennis has coached for 26 years at the High School Varsity level in Maryland. (Please see attached sheet for accomplishments in this area).
