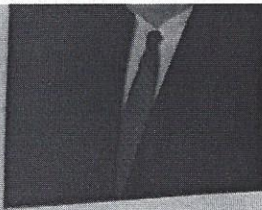
His expertise and influence within the legal profession inspired two of his own children, David and Jack, to become attorneys in our community thereby carrying on the family name and profession.

Here on this stage we say goodbye to our years at Bishop Fallon High School. Yet we know that this is not an ending but another beginning. It is a commencement. Now we step onto a larger stage to audition for an even more challenging role, than the one we have just played. Only time will tell who will star, who will be mediocre and who will fail.

My name is Vince Sanchez.

I speak to you on behalf of the senior class of 1963. We want to tell you in words and in pictures about the training that we have received under the guidance of the Oblates of Mary Immaculate at Bishop Fallon High School. We tried to be very subtle about our training by opening with a folio of pictures in groups of threes. One picture depicted some aspect of physical training, another some aspect of intellectual training and the third some aspect of spiritual training. This three-fold training in matters physical, intellectual and spiritual is our story as we proudly present
