

Kevin is a 1963 graduate of Bishop Fallon High School. His younger brother Jim later followed, graduating in 1968. Kevin played football all four years at BFHS, he also participated in field events for the track team. In his junior year, he rowed with the Fallon crew, competing in the Canadian School Boys regatta at the Henley course at Port Dalhousie, Ontario.

In 1966, Kevin enlisted in the US Army. He served as a Battalion Supply Clerk for Headquarters, 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion, 51<sup>st</sup> Infantry, 4<sup>th</sup> Armored Division in Crailsheim, Germany. Upon his honorable discharge in January 1968, Kevin returned home to complete his undergraduate studies at Canisius College. He graduated from Canisius in 1974, having earned a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration.

Kevin spent ten years working in the railroad industry; working in freight sales positions for Lehigh Valley RR, Delaware and Hudson RR, and Chessie System RR (later CSX). Electing not to transfer out of town so that he could remain close to his daughter, Kevin secured employment with the Erie County Department of Social services when CSX relocated its headquarters. He worked in the county's Special Investigations Division for several years.

Later, Kevin was hired as an investigator with the Labor Standards Division of the New York State Department of Labor. He had a 19-year career with the Department of Labor, first in Labor Standards, then in Public Employee Safety and Health (PESH), and finally as an OSHA consultant. Kevin spent his last two years at NYSDOL as an OSHA safety trainer, sharing his vast knowledge and experience with businesses to ensure they were operating safely.

Kevin retired in 2008 and spent his free time traveling and camping. Kevin has served the Buffalo/WNY area for years in various organizations that provide support to people. He has mentored numerous individuals, using his own experiences to help encourage others. From 2002-2005 and again from 2022-2025, Kevin served on the BFHS/HACI Board of Directors. He takes great pride in his time at BFHS and enjoys being active within the alumni association.
